Object: on the equivalence of grading scales used at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics and at the Florida Institute of Technology

To whom it may concern,


The Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME) and the Florida Institute of Technology (FIT) run an EU-US Atlantis type student exchange program. In the framework of this exchange programs the FIT allows credits transfer based on studies at the BME.

Based on our experiences and on the consultation with Dr. Bálint Kiss, the BME coordinator of the exchange program, the following equivalence is suggested between the grading scales.

| BME grade | FIT grade |
|------------------|------------------|
| 5 (excellent) | A |
| 4 (good) | A |
| 3 (satisfactory) | B |
| 2 (pass) | C (or D) |
| 1 (fail) | F (fail) |

We provide this equivalence table as a possible option for the evaluation of the official BME transcripts at the FIT.
